

Breeding Chickens

Eggs should be collected each day if you want to hatch chicks from them.

They can be stored in an egg carton with the pointy end down.

Your hands should be clean when collecting eggs.

Eggs should be kept away from the sunlight.

Do not keep your eggs longer than two weeks before putting them in an incubator.

It is best if you don't wash eggs that you are going to incubate. The eggs you choose should also be clean.
