In your writing task, you should show good evidence of:

Planning - key ideas, diagrams, notes, lists.

Correct spelling - try to include more challenging words.

Correct punctuation - good use of capitals, full stops, commas, semi-colon, colon, speech marks, question marks.

Correct use of paragraphs - 5 paragraphs if possible. One intro, one conclusion and three for the body of text.

Simple, compound and three different types of complex sentences - Avoid run-on sentences. EDIT your writing for these!

Using a range of **adjectives, adverbs** and figurative language. (eg. Simile, metaphor)

Write with creativity and make it interesting, showing evidence of EDITING therefore improving your writing.
